You must have your helmet on at all times. There will be no exceptions. Violators can and will be asked to leave the Park with no refund. In addition, this applies to all people, young or old at this event racing or not.

If you have any questions surrounding the track or scoring system, please ONLY see your assigned Club Representatives. The club rep. list will be posted at the sign-up location throughout the race. Please DO NOT interrupt or disturb the scorekeepers or track personnel. Again, your club representative can address your problem of issue and help you resolve it through the appropriate channel.

The Sierra Old Timers would also appreciate your continued assistance in keeping the park free of litter. Please recycle all your plastic, glass and aluminum containers and place all garbage in the receptacles nearest your camping or seating location.

Rules and Procedures of the International Vet MX Association
Committee are in effect at this event and will be followed. Please keep that
in mind.

- Protests may only be lodged by the riders in the same moto and must be lodged with the rider's chapter representative in writing, within one half hour of the completion of the moto in question.
- If a rider leaves the track, they must safely re-enter as close to the point of exit without improving position.
- Changing motorcycles during moto will be cause for disqualification.
- Score keepers must be notified of bike number changes.
- When a yellow flag is displayed, there is no passing or jumping between the flag and the incident that caused yellow flag.
- Number plate background colors will be enforced for IVMX Classes.
- Masters: Black background with White numbers
- Experts: White background with Black numbers
- Intermediates: Yellow background with Black numbers
- Novices: Green background with White numbers
 Note: Single event riders will be allowed to use a strip of appropriate colored
 tape applied horizontally above and below the number.

Decisions made by the Presiding Riding Committee are final

Abusive language or aggressive conduct toward race officials, scorers or volunteers will not be tolerated. Racers engaging in this behavior are subjected to ejection from the event and their entry fees and points forfeited.


